The purpose of this document is to provide an analysis of pursuits that occurred in the year 2022 at the Clinton County Sheriff's Office.

For comparison purposes, the Clinton County Sheriff's Office had involvement in five (5) documented vehicular pursuits in the year 2020 and eleven (11) documented pursuits in 2021. In 2022 the Clinton County Sheriff's Office had six (6) documented vehicular pursuits which reflects an decrease in vehicular pursuits from the previous year.

In reviewing officer's actions during these pursuits it is our opinion that officer's acted within the policy guidelines of the Clinton County Sheriff's Office.

Additionally, our office has completed a review of our policy and procedure pertaining to vehicular pursuits and do not feel any changes or updates are needed at this time. It should be noted that our agency does not currently use tire deflation devices nor the PIT maneuver so no training is required relating to those techniques.
